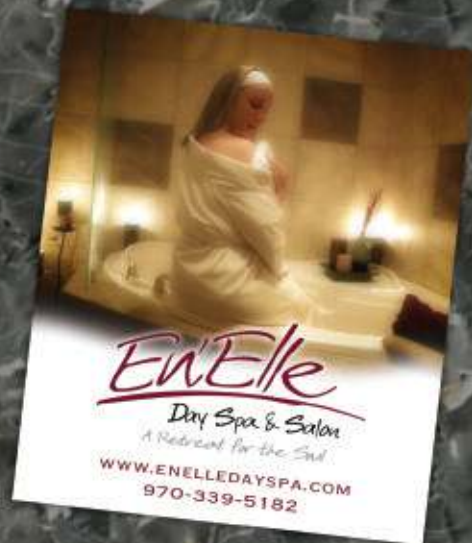

Businesses 'think outside' at offsite meeting venues

Find new perspectives and ideas by meeting away from the office

There was a time, not so long ago, when big companies rooted in Northern Colorado regularly went off site for planning sessions led by well-compensated consultants. Exuberant hiring practices of the 1990s filled corporate sites to bursting, and so leaving the mothership for a day or two just made sense.

Since the crunch, business retreats and offsite meetings have become more compact high-touch, high-value gatherings.

“When companies started downsizing and laying people off, there was suddenly plenty of room to hold meetings on site,” said Kerry Schroeder who, with her husband Mike, owns the Cottonwood Club in Fort Collins. “We have owned this business for 11 years now, and as the corporate part of our business has changed, we have looked to other opportunities.”

With the possible exception of Tamasag in Bellvue, the Griffith Foundation's bucolic gathering place for nonprofit/educational organizations, most small to medium-sized event venue owners regard business meetings and retreats as an off-season sliver of the income pie, and concentrate on more lucrative social events.

However, there is good evidence that a well-conducted off-site meeting can improve the bottom line for any size business.

“We all have a feeling about what it means to walk into the office, and most of it is good,” said Courtney Pullen, a

Denver-based management consultant. “It means 'time to get started,' 'time to focus on the job at hand.' But on a regular basis, it is important to think outside those office

walls. It doesn't have to be at the Broadmoor, but it should be away.”

breakfast and lunch (typical for standing meetings), for a full day including dinner or for an evening event.

“Businesses have become more careful about where they go,” Kerry Schroeder said. “They are looking for a good setting, good food and good service.”

Schroeder explained that the strong suit for the Cottonwood Club is accommodating the group of 35 to 40 that wants to get away from the office and hash something out.

“The success of an off-site meeting depends on the participants' believing that the agenda is valuable to them,” she said. “If there is a speaker, that person needs to meet the needs of the audience. What we provide

is an environment that allows people to be totally focused and feel well taken care of.”

Like The Cottonwood Club, Tapestry House and Event Center in Laporte northwest of Fort Collins derives most of its income from hosting social events, weddings in particular. However, its reputation for service in that market has translated into interest from local businesses.

“We have owned Tapestry House for two years now, with 2005 as our first full season,” said Robin VanNorman, who owns the business with her sister and brother-in-law, Bobbie and Mark Randolph. “We wanted to get established with our primary business before we started exploring other markets.”

Jen Zander, office manager, added that since the wedding/social gathering market got off to such a good start — 183 events as of October — the owners are exploring the small, but interesting, business meeting market.

“In the house, we can accommodate 25 people. They can bring in their own

He added that the value of an off-site meeting gets an extra boost with the addition of a facilitator, someone who can change the staff meeting dynamic by releasing the boss or manager to participate.

“The goal of a retreat is for everyone to have an opportunity to step back from the business and look at it from a renewed and strategic perspective,” he said. “Bringing in a facilitator alerts everyone that this process will be different and significant.”

Among event venues in Northern Colorado, three locations — The Cottonwood Club, Tapestry House and Sylvan Dale Guest Ranch — represent high-quality venues that share an “away” feeling, but vary in terms of accommodations.

Good setting, good food, good service

The Cottonwood Club, located on South College Avenue two miles south of Harmony Road, is invisible from the road: away, but not too far away. Companies can book meetings for

food, which makes the cost more flexible," she said. "We can also accommodate larger groups in any of the three rooms in the pavilion. The main dining room can become a classroom for 100."

VanNorman said that even without advertising, Tapestry House has attracted a variety of business groups, from First National Bank in Fort Collins to the Poudre Valley Hospital Foundation and the payroll processing company ADP.

"People come out here to an event and pass the word along," she said. "A management retreat is supposed to be a creative occasion, and it's easier to be creative in a beautiful setting with good service."

VanNorman acknowledged that because hotels can often "give away" the meeting room that comes with a meal, Tapestry House cannot compete on the room costs.

"Here you pay \$300 for up to 25 attendees for either the house or the gallery in the pavilion, but you can bring your own lunch or have it catered," she said.

On the matter of competition between offsite venues like Tapestry House and a hotel, Pullen comes down on the side of the smaller site in a natural setting.

"People tend to think differently and more creatively when they are in a new and relaxing environment," he said.

Multiple days require rooms

Pullen also advises companies to set out two days for a retreat rather than one.

"Two days gives people the freedom to have a big dinner on the second day and to invite spouses and other family members," he said. "People feel celebrated and cared for."

While it is certainly possible to conduct a two-day retreat as strictly day sessions, spending the night away offers additional opportunities for team building and family participation. Sylvan Dale Guest Ranch, just west of Loveland near the entry to the Big Thompson Canyon, offers dis-

counted off-season rates to attract groups looking for a unique setting to plan and build collegiality.

"During the summer, our business is week-long family vacations," said Lois Pierson, group sales coordinator and head of administrative support. "In the fall, winter and spring, we have more business groups and retreats. A pretty typical stay for a group of 11 to 15 is two nights and three days. We get very little snow, and so it's possible to take a walk or a horseback ride."

And to add to the sense of true retreat, the lodgings, while modern in every other way, have no telephones, no TVs and no radios. Cell phone service is spotty, but staff can point to high spots on the ranch where it is possible to get a signal.

"We do have a little business center with Internet and fax access," said Mary Bahus-Meyer, marketing manager. "But people come here because it is a place to 'think outside.' It's an inspiring place to come and plan a budget or a future."

Like its namesake, Fox Acres is a rare breed. It's a glorious getaway. A wildlife preserve, and a place where families and friends can reaffirm their connection to nature and each other. A serene setting like no other,

Make networking events work for your business

Make new contacts over drinks and jazz at social meet-and-eats

On any given day, countless conferences, conventions and cocktail parties are taking place with the common goal of bringing businesspeople and enterprises together.

Networking remains one of the best ways to make new business contacts or strengthen existing ones.

To create networking success, experts say a well-designed event gets guests engaged and talking. Pay attention to a few key elements to facilitate networking — and make your event a success.

Food

Action stations with onsite chefs, like a stir-fry or sauté station, are one way to get people to gather and mingle. To avoid bottlenecks, make sure to spread the menu throughout the room. For example, if you have 10 menu items, have several stations with three items at each.

Also avoid food that requires a knife. Serve items that can be eaten using just a fork, or better yet, using one's fingers so people can comfortably hold a plate in one hand and a beverage in the other while moving about the room.

Drinks

If you are serving cocktails, have servers floating among the guests. Servers should know expected arrival times for guests and be near the entrance at those times.

This helps guests feel welcome and relaxed right away. It also helps keep guests out of long bar lines so more min-

gling can take place.

Scattering food and drink stations throughout the room also encourages guests to move around. For good foot traffic flow, avoid putting

food, drink or sign-up station near the entrance. This causes crowds to clutter the area.

Setup

You can also open up floor space by avoiding large guest-seating tables. Use smaller tables or standing cabaret tables of varying sizes, shapes and heights to create intimate conversation spaces.

Too much seating or seating that is too comfortable will slow movement throughout the room. An expert's rule of thumb is to provide enough seating to accommodate about one-third to one-half of the crowd.

The venue itself can be a conversation piece. Museums and art galleries always make interesting venues, and chambers of commerce hold regular after- and before-hours at local businesses to showcase their members.

Entertainment

Music and entertainment also play a role in the overall feel and energy of an event. DJs have their purpose but are not always ideal for corporate events. Live musicians, such as a jazz trio, harpist or guitarist, are fun to watch and are also a perfect backdrop for undisturbed conversation and dining.

Some thoughtful planning and creative placements can go a long way toward fostering communication and business networking among guests.

Networking with style

With the party all set for networking, what should you discuss and how do you break the ice? Networking comes easily

to some, but others need practice. There are a number of things to help make the most of networking opportunities.

- Get a list of attendees in advance so you can target your prospects. Make a list of people you would like to meet or be introduced to at the event. Once you arrive, it may be difficult to figure out whom to talk to first. Approach small groups of three or more people or someone who is alone. Groups of two may be engaged in a more intimate conversation.

- Approach people you don't know. Have your "elevator pitch" — a 30- to 60-second introduction of yourself and your business — ready to help break the ice. And make sure to listen to what the other person has to say. Think if there's a way your company could help theirs, or possibly point them to another person in the room who could.

- Make a point of having a business card and a brochure about your company you can hand out. Make sure to include your company's Web site address on the card and brochure.

- Remember the handshake can say a lot about you when meeting someone for the first time. A firm handshake shows confidence and respect. Hold your glass in your left hand since no one likes to receive a slippery handshake. Also, wear your nametag on your right-hand side so it is in the line of sight of someone shaking your hand.

- Don't monopolize anyone's time. If a person seems interested in what you have to say, offer your business card and ask for a convenient time to call. And when you are ready to end the conversation, do so gracefully and with a smile. Thank the person and tell him or her you have enjoyed your talk.

With these tips in mind, you will be able to successfully navigate any networking event with panache, and come away with at least one beneficial contact.

What the large print giveth, small print can taketh away

For a worry-free event, understand all contracts

In planning any event, chances are you are going to have to sign a contract, perhaps several. Caterers, venues, event planners and other vendors should each require a completed contract to protect themselves as much as their clients. And, as with almost every contract ever conceived by an attorney, there is likely to be some fine print.

Make sure you stay on top of the stipulations of these contracts, if you want to save time and money. The first step is to spend some time actually reading the contract and understanding what it says, especially in the crucial "Terms and Conditions" segment.

If there's anything you don't understand, ask before you sign. If you e-mail your questions, you'll have a written record of the vendor's response.

Here are some key considerations, as shared by local caterers and event planners:

- Know your bottom-line price, especially if you are booking something far (six months or more) in advance.

An event planner must know whether the price that's quoted is the actual price, or whether the price is subject to change after the fact. For instance, since Sept. 11, 2001, terrorism clauses have become common to protect against loss in the event of an attack. More mundane clauses cover provisions for unanticipated spikes in the cost of food items, or whether your final price depends on booking a certain

minimum number of rooms, for example.

- Is your deposit refundable in the event of a cancellation? Often, it is not. A standard deposit is about 25 percent of the total estimate, paid in advance.

The purpose of a deposit is to cover

expenses that a caterer or planner could incur before the actual event.

There may also be specific penalties for cancellations or rebookings within certain timeframes, such as two weeks before the event. In nearly every case, items that are missing, damaged or destroyed will likely be tacked onto your bill, either by the caterer or by the venue.

- Watch for hidden labor costs. Some

service providers will charge a standard percentage, while others charge a cost-per-worker fee.

Know what the labor costs are going to be before your event, and what you'll be charged if more people are needed at the last minute if you make changes to the event.

- When do you need to give the caterer or venue a final head count? This vital piece of information lets the vendors know how much food and what supplies will be required. Some will want the guarantee number a week before the event, but that deadline will vary

between companies. Be certain to know the requirements before you sign.

The more you buy, the cheaper it can be. You will pay less per person to serve 1,000 people than you will with 500 people. But be sure your estimate is correct. If you say that you have 1,000 affirmative RSVPs and only 800 show, you are not going to be reimbursed for the 200 who did not come.

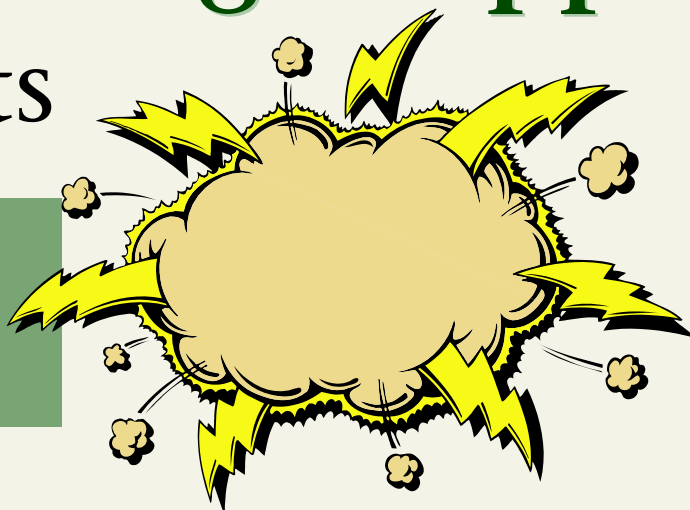

When bad things happen at good events

Thorough preparation best form of crisis management



Professional event planners will tell you Murphy's Law is not a suggestion but an iron-clad rule.

But when the inevitable does go wrong, it does not have to spoil the occasion or dent the host's image. Most often, it's not the error that reflects on the host, but how he or she reacts to the crisis. Remain calm, be creative, and keep the enjoyment of your guests always uppermost in your mind.

And when planning an event, remember that preparation is your best crisis management. Try to imagine the worst-case scenario, then plan ahead, just in case.

Here are some common crises and how seasoned event planners would handle them.

1. Crisis: Food or drinks disappear before guests do.

Solution: To best prevent this, start with an accurate headcount. Pad it, just in case.

If your event is not being held in a venue with a food and beverage operation, think creatively about delivery of additional items. Chinese restaurants offer appetizers and entrees. Pizza places often offer garlic bread or breadsticks.

Call in reinforcements. Send a friend to the closest grocery store for wine, beer, pre-made deli platters or baked goods.

2. Crisis: Venue inconveniences a VIP by asking for credit card on a paid room, keeping him or her waiting, losing the valet parking ticket, or otherwise dropping the ball.

Solution: First, address the VIP.

Acknowledge the inconvenience, and that you are working to make things right.

Communicate with venue staff immediately. Reputable venues are staffed by professionals trained to manage these dicey situations.

Arrange a token of apology, such as a gift basket.

3. Crisis: Uncooperative weather generates cold temperatures, hurricane-like gusts or ankle-deep floods just in time for your outdoor event.

Solution: Plan ahead. Be prepared with an alternative venue and an indoor back-up plan.

If guests are inconvenienced by weather — stranded at a hotel due to a cancelled flights or closed roads, for example — plan ahead to entertain them. Change travel arrangements on their behalf.

The weather is not your fault, but act like it is. Thank your guests for

their patience.

4. Crisis: The caterer cancels at the last minute, miscalculates food or underestimates staffing needs.

Solution: Insist on a detailed contract that spells out such things before booking the event.

Communicate closely before and during the event. Professional caterers will have contingency plans and will discuss them with you.

Be observant, and ask questions: Are we running low on anything? How are we with the appetizers?

Be prepared to pitch in: tend bar, clear tables, chop tomatoes. Adjust tip accordingly.

5. Crisis: Inebriated guests threaten to trash your party — and reputation.

Solution: Hire professional bartenders. They are trained in the art of denying service to someone who has had too many.

Designate someone to check in with the bartender throughout the event to get the update on guests who are overdoing it.

If possible, have a friend of the guest take the guest home. If necessary, call a cab. When it arrives, discreetly escort the guest to the cab. Give the driver directions and cab fare.

6. Crisis: Major party foul: a guest ends up with a lap full of marinara sauce or red wine.

Solution: Discreetly escort guest to room to change. Arrange for venue to provide clothing items as needed, or spectacular room service if guest decides

not to return to function.

Resist the temptation to reprimand staff members. Use discretion. They are professionals and will help you remedy the situation.

Have soiled clothing cleaned immediately at your expense.

Send gift basket and note of apology.

7. Crisis: Entertainment or speaker pulls a no-show.

Solution: Include a back-up plan - an alternate speaker, a video, a stack of CDs and a stereo — in pre-event planning.

Speak positively to the audience about the new arrangement.

8. Crisis: The unthinkable happens, such as a medical emergency, fire alarm, sprinkler activation.

Solution: Discuss disaster plan, including evacuation, with venue staff prior to event. Carry emergency numbers with you at all times. Inquire about security and fire systems.

Move guests to a safe location.

Apologize for inconvenience.

Communicate situation, reparations and next steps.

Arrange thank-you notes and tokens of apology.

9. Crisis: A/V equipment won't cooperate.

Solution: Even if it is provided, bring your own as a backup.

If this event is critical, bring two of everything.

Carry three extra bulbs for the projector.

Bring a laser pointer.

Bring an extension cord configured for at least three plugs.

Bring a remote for the laptop.

10. Crisis: Handouts get lost or ruined.

Solution: Keep a full set separate from rest. You may need them to photocopy.

Bring computer disk or flash drive with handouts on it.

What's in your toolkit?

With a little foresight and a few strategic items always on hand, the savvy event planner can keep small emergencies from ballooning into major disasters. A survey of professional event Macgyvers turned up these "must haves" for an onsite toolkit.

■ Cell phone/PDA

What can we say? It's a lifeline.

■ Extra batteries

For cameras, recorders, handheld pointers, microphones and other gadgets.

■ Voice recorder

During the heat of an event, the planner could field many questions from frenetic attendees or stressed-out clients. Rather than writing them all down, a quick message is both quicker and time saving. Also allows the planner to play back reminders of things to get done.

■ Scissors/flower cutters

One never knows when a quick snip or a flower arrangement fix is necessary.

■ First-aid kit

Adhesive bandages for minor scrapes or cuts, anti-bacterial ointment, tweezers and hand sanitizers are all good to have.

■ Roll of quarters

Pay phones are still useful if a cell phone battery dies or the location does not have service.

■ Baby wipes

Not just for bottoms, they can clean a table top, refresh sweaty palms or shine wingtips, too.

■ Safety pins

Faster than needle and thread at the last minute and good for anything.

■ Office supplies

Pens, sign holders, tape, markers, glue sticks, staplers and the greatest invention of the 20th century, sticky notes, can work wonders.

■ Miscellaneous electronics cables

The U in USB cables stands for Universal, and having an extra around can't hurt. Extension cords and surge protectors are mighty handy, too.

■ Antacids/pain relievers

Comes in handy for the client, the keynote speaker or the planner.

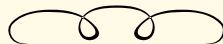

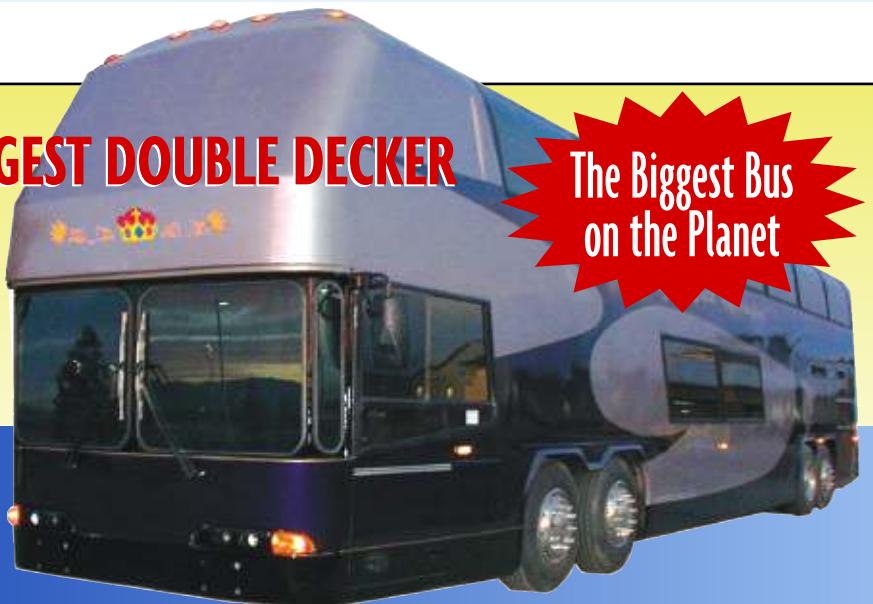


