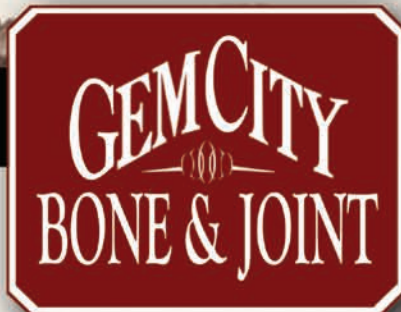

LONG-AWAITED HARMONY TEES OFF

Eng's latest creation will provide the ultimate test for brave golfers

Eng's Colorado portfolio

Castle Rock golf architect Jim Eng opens his eighth Colorado course, the Golf Course at Harmony, in July. Other Eng creations in the state have landed on the sport's "best courses" lists with regularity. They include:

- **Sanctuary**, the 18-hole private hideaway in Sedalia commissioned by millionaire Re/Max real estate founder Dave Liniger that is a popular venue for charity tournaments, and that Golf Digest ranked among the world's 150 best courses.
- **Fossil Trace Golf Course**, a spectacular municipal course on the southern edge of Golden that opened for play to rave reviews in 2003, and was high among Golf Digest's "best new courses" that year.
- **The Golf Club at Redlands Mesa**, chiseled out of the spectacular canyon country on the southern edge of Grand Junction and nudging the tops of "best public courses" lists by major golf publications.
- **Red Hawk Ridge Golf Course**, a municipal course in Castle Rock where James Eng Golf is headquartered, and one of Eng's first Colorado designs.
- **Lakota Canyon Ranch Golf Club outside New Castle**, similar to Redlands Mesa in that its fairways and greens follow the natural canyon contours and where tee boxes are sometimes perched 100 feet above fairways.
- Rounding out the list of Eng's Colorado projects are the **Pradera Golf Club**, a private, prairie-style course in Parker, and **Snowmass Club**, the alpine wonder near Aspen.

TIMNATH — Golf course designer Jim Eng got his first look at Nelson Farm, a 640-acre sheep ranch two miles east of tiny Timnath flanking the north side of Harmony Road, in 2001.

He viewed the rolling meadows, cottonwood groves and sheep pens as a sculptor views a block of marble. "This project has so much appeal," he said at the time. "Have you been out to walk around that property? It's really going to be a spectacular place."

Six years later Eng, named the world's No. 1 golf architect in 2003 by leading sport publication Golf Digest, has put his unique stamp on an 18-hole championship layout — the Golf Course at Harmony. Among Northern Colorado golf aficionados, no other course has been so talked-about during its opening year.

For example, people are marveling already at hole No. 7., a par-3 layout with a narrow, 100-yard-deep green that snakes between bunkers. It can play at 130 yards or 230 yards, depending on pin placement. Even before anyone has played a full round of golf at Harmony, No. 7 is etched in local golf lore.

The three-member development team that is blending Eng's masterpiece into a residential community that will feature some of Northern Colorado's grandest homes has also assembled a dream team to direct golf operations, all of them Professional Golfers' Association Class-A professionals.

Two are returning Northern Colorado golf veterans. Steve "Seve" Lind, former pro at the Eaton Country Club and Fox Acres Country Club in Red Feather Lakes, was

A ROUND AROUND WYOMING

A whole lot of holes Fore! you

With its high altitudes and long winters, Wyoming will never be a year-round golfing destination. But when spring and then glorious summer finally arrives, the state just might be a golfer's paradise.

From championship courses beneath scenic mountain peaks to hometown links carefully laid across rolling prairies, Wyoming offers something for every golfer.

And the nice thing about playing a round here is you don't have to rush. Whether it takes you a season or a lifetime, golfing Wyoming presents an experience that few will ever forget.

Our goal this year is to introduce you to the gamut of fine golf courses that dot the state's broad expanse and so you can play your way along what we call the Great Wyoming Golf Tour.

With some 60 courses to play, you'll drive some 2,300 miles to play some 372 holes of golf — 348,000 yards in all — and we think you'll experience some of the friendliest golfing opportunities in the region.

Cheyenne has variety

Let's start our tour in Cheyenne, Wyoming's Capital City, which offers five courses to choose from. The Cheyenne Country Club and the F.E. Warren Air Force Base offer contiguous, challenging courses, while just across Interstate 25 lies the city of Cheyenne's Airport Golf Club.

Together, those three courses offer some of the best 54 holes in a concentrated space in Wyoming. Add in the nine-hole courses at Little America Resort just down I-25 and Kingham Prairie View, another city course a few miles

east off Dell Range Boulevard, and you have five courses that will delight you for a week or more. Plus we recommend the 90-mile roundtrip east to Pine Bluffs and its nine-hole Leaning Rock Golf Course. It may not have a lot of players, but that adds to its charm.

Then it's 70 miles up I-25 to the Wheatland Golf Club, a nicely landscaped par-72 course north of Cheyenne. Then on to Guernsey's Trail Ruts Golf Club (another 29 miles), where you can play 18 in the footsteps of Oregon Trail pioneers.

Next on the Great Wyoming Golf Tour comes the Torrington Municipal Golf Course, another nicely landscaped course along the North Platte River (33 miles) and then north to Lusk and the Niobrara Country Club (57 miles) with its 6,492-yard course.

No tour of eastern Wyoming courses would be complete without heading to the rolling hills of the Douglas Community Golf Club (55 miles), a 6,300-yard par-71 course that also offers a full-service restaurant. We'll finish up at the Glenrock Golf Club (30 miles) for another pleasant 18.

Three Crowns enhances Casper

Our tour next takes us 24 miles up the North Platte River to Casper, one of the state's premier golf destinations now with the addition of the Three Crowns Golf Course, a championship course on rolling hills that once housed Amoco's historic Casper Refinery.

The Robert Trent Jones course enters its second year with a new deck for outdoor dining and the same great views of Casper Mountain, downtown Casper and the North Platte.

“Hole No. 7 offers our golfers the ultimate challenge,” says general manager David Raper. “Your tee shot must be long and straight on this beautiful dogleg par 4. Casper Mountain looms in the background as you play from an elevated tee area. Be careful not to cut too much off of the dogleg or your tee shot will end up in a lake that guards the entire left side of this hole. Too long and you will end up in one of two expertly placed bunkers.”

Birdies are common on No. 7 at Three Crowns, but Raper advises that “a careless golfer may end up with double bogey or higher.”

But don’t forget Casper’s three other courses — the Casper Country Club, the Casper Golf Club and the Paradise Valley Country Club. All are fine 18-hole courses with all the amenities one would expect from country clubs in Wyoming’s second-largest city.

Paradise Valley is the longest of the three at 7,000 yards, followed by the Casper Golf Club with 6,500 yards and the Casper Country Club at 6,046 yards.

Northeast offers challenges

From Casper, we’ll head toward northeastern Wyoming’s Black Hills and some of the state’s prettiest courses, stop-

ping first in Midwest (47 miles) to play the Salt Creek Country Club, a 3,004-yard, par-70 course carved out of a working oil field where you can watch the deer and antelope and sometimes a cow play while you play.

Then we head into the heart of the Powder River Basin and the Haycreek Golf Club at Wright (51 miles). Haycreek is a 6,854-yard, nine-hole course with a signature hole (No. 4, 422 yards) that is a dogleg right, with water left and right all the way to the green, which is surrounded by hazards.

Another 38 miles takes us up Wyoming Highway 59 to Gillette, home of the long 7,258-yard Bell Nob Golf Course, with its new companion course for kids, Wee Links at Bell Nob, and the Gillette Golf Club, no slouch itself at 6,694 yards.

Then it’s on to the Black Hills, stopping en route at Pinehaven (40 miles) for a round at the Keyhole Country Club and Upton (34 miles) at the Cedar Pines Country Club and on to Newcastle (26 miles), home of the Newcastle County Club.

From Newcastle, we head north to Sundance (45 miles) and the par-70 Sundance Country Club and then to Hulett (39 miles), home of one of the newest golf courses in the

state, the recently expanded Devils Tower Golf Club. Devils Tower added nine holes last year, while its namesake, the nation's first national monument, was celebrating its centennial.

Big Horn Wonderland

We'll backtrack to Gillette (68 miles) and on to Buffalo (70 miles) to tour the Big Horn Mountains. First stop is the Buffalo Golf Club, a par-71, 6,556-yard course at the base of the Big Horns, and then to Sheridan (35 miles), another major golf destination in Wyoming.

First comes the Powder Horn Golfing Community, considered by many to be one of the state's best. Three distinct, nationally acclaimed, nine-hole courses await the serious golfer. They were carved out of an old cattle ranch by developer Homer Scott Jr., and offer trophy views of the Big Horns along with trophy home sites and a new clubhouse, itself a trophy.

Sheridan also boasts the 6,800-yard Kendrick Golf Course and the 6,225-yard Sheridan Country Club, and another 18-hole course is in the planning stages. Plus, the Horseshoe Mountain Golf Club is just up I-90 in Dayton

(26 miles), adding another nine for your enjoyment.

Then it's across the Big Horns (83 miles) and down into the Big Horn Basin, where six interesting courses make a perfect circle tour. First is Basin's Midway Golf Club, a 6,492-yard course near the Big Horn River. We'll head to Worland next (31 miles) for a round at the Green Hills Golf Club, with its 6,462 yards, and then north to Powell (93 miles) and Powell Country Club, a 6,705-yarder.

Cody (24 miles) offers the Olive Glenn Golf and Country Club and 6,515 yards of fun and sport. It's south to Meeteetse (31 miles) and the Pine Rock Golf Course, a par 36, nine-hole course with 3,600 yards, and then end our circle tour in Thermopolis (52 miles). The Legion Town and Country Club is a par-70, 6,051-yard course, overlooking the Big Horn River and Thermopolis' famous hot springs, where we can take the waters if we're a little stiff.



National Park Byways

Wind River Country offers more than just fishing, hunting and backpacking for sports enthusiasts. Our first stop is Riverton (55 miles), where the Renegade Golf Course and Riverton Country Club offer a combined 36 holes of golf, before heading toward Yellowstone and Grand Teton national parks. Riverton Country Club is a 7,014-yard, par-72 course, while Renegade comes in at par 70, 6,206 yards.

Lander, 25 miles to the south, sports another scenic and challenging 18-hole course at the 5,830-yard Lander Golf & Country Club. Our tour then takes us to Dubois (75 miles) and the Antelope Hills Golf Course, a scenic par-72, 6,274-yard course nestled in the foothills above the Wind River.

Yellowstone Park is a great tour on its own, but not for golf, so we'll drive through Grand Teton Park to Jackson (86 miles), another of Wyoming's premier golfing destinations with both world-class views and challenging links.

Five spectacular courses are located in and around Jackson Hole, including the newly refurbished Jackson Hole Golf and Tennis Club; Teton Pines Country Club; the new 3 Creek Ranch Golf Club, and the even newer Snake River

Sporting Club, which opened last summer. The fifth venue, the Targhee Village Golf Course, will require an 80-mile roundtrip side trip into Idaho and back, but it's worth it.

Any golfer who gets the opportunity to play any of the Jackson-area courses will be sure to remember the views, if not their scores.

Southwest treasures

Just south of Jackson Hole in Star Valley lie more hidden gems, and beyond them are several exciting courses carved out of the desert of southwest Wyoming.

Star Valley Ranch near Thayne (53 miles) offers two distinct courses — the nine-hole Aspen Hills course and the 18-hole Cedar Creek course. Just down the road in Afton (15 miles) lies the Valli Vu Golf Club, another 18-hole course nestled in scenic splendor beneath the Salt River Mountain Range.

From Star Valley, we'll head south to Evanston (120 miles) and the Purple Sage Golf Club, a par-72, 7,000-yard course with a number of interesting holes. Then we'll head back north to Kemmerer (50 miles) and nine-hole Kemmerer Field Club and then farther north to Pinedale (105 miles) and the Rendezvous

Meadows Golf Club, another scenic 18-hole course.

Then it's south to Green River (113 miles) and the Rolling Green Country Club, a 6,500-yard, par-72 course, and then a short 14-mile hop to Rock Springs and its White Mountain Golf Course, somewhat longer at 7,129 yards.

Southern Wyoming gems

We head east on I-80 to Rawlins (108 miles), where the new Rochelle Ranch Course offers golfers just five yards shy of 8,000 yards to practice their long games. The Rochelle Course is located just off I-80 east of Rawlins and boasts something rare in the Red Desert — plenty of water hazards.

Water is no problem at the Sinclair Golf Club, which lies along the North Platte River just a few miles farther east. The Sinclair course, on the road to Seminole Reservoir, is shorter than Rochelle at 5,485 yards.

A short jaunt upriver brings us to Saratoga (42 miles) and two more scenic courses — the Old Baldy Club and the Saratoga Inn Golf Club. Both are nestled along the North Platte, with scenic views of the Snowy Range and Sierra Madre Mountains. The 6,649-yard Old Baldy course

includes the monster 10th hole, a 568-yard par 5. The Saratoga Inn course is a scenic nine-hole course where you start your round from a tee on a rock the size of a house.

Across the Snowy Range lies Laramie (79 miles), home of the University of Wyoming and its very nice Glenn “Red” Jacoby Golf Course, named after a former UW athletic director, and the nine-hole Laramie Country Club south of town. The 18-hole Jacoby Course, just east of the UW campus, is slated to get a nine-hole expansion over the next several years.

From Laramie, we drive “over the hill” back to Cheyenne (49 miles) and conclude our Great Wyoming Golf Tour. We will have driven some 2,300 miles circling the state, but the rewards should easily outnumber the miles driven.

We will have driven golf balls approximately 348,000 yards on our 60-course tour. That's nearly 200 miles worth of golf. We will have played some 972 holes of golf, some easy, many challenging and almost all enjoyable. And our scores? Oh the scores! Even making par, they'll be in the thousands. But oh, what a round!

lured away from his most recent job as director of golf at Canyon Gate Country Club in Las Vegas, one of the Nevada golf capital’s most prestigious courses.

Pro lineup

Harmony developers Byron Collins, a longtime friend of Lind, and Mark Tingey brought Lind back as the linchpin of the golf staff, naming him director of golf operations in February. And, after six years in Las Vegas’ high-powered and hard-driving golf market, Lind said he was ready for the homecoming.

“The excitement of working with Byron and Mark, and their vision of what they wanted to do here, was really what did it for me,” Lind said. “Club golf in Las Vegas was a very numbers-driven game. But Byron and Mark are not driven by greed. They’re not all about making money.”

The philosophy shows up in the way a golf course and residential community coexist on Harmony’s square mile

of land. Homeowners have views that feature vistas of mountains and plains more than fairways, and golfers don’t have the feeling of being in someone’s back yard.

“My first impression was the uniqueness of the property,” Lind said. “The No. 1 thing is how far the homes are removed from the golf course. There are 80- to 100-yard setbacks. They could have easily put 1,000 home sites on that property. They have 480.”

The development team hired as Harmony’s head golf professional Ben Zatz, formerly first-assistant pro at the Tournament Players Club course at Avenel, a PGA tour tournament venue in Potomac, Md.

Zatz had arrived in Fort Collins, jobless, in December when his wife accepted a position as staff attorney for Poudre Valley Health System. Ironically, he at the same time had been offered his dream job as head professional at another TPC course in Illinois.

“That was my dream, to be a head professional hosting a PGA tour event, but we weighed Moline, Ill., against

Fort Collins, and it was an easy decision,” Zatz said. “I see Harmony as the best private golf facility in the Northern Colorado region. Everything that has been put into it has gone in with the utmost care.

Rounding out the golf staff is PGA professional Todd Coover, who also served as Fox Acres head professional and whose resume also includes pro terms at Bear Creek Golf Club in Denver and Hyland Hills Golf Course in Westminster.

CSU's new home

Under construction and nearing completion at Harmony's southern gateway is the 8,000-square-foot Harmony Center, the new headquarters for the Harmony development staff but, more importantly, the new home for Colorado State University men's and women's golf programs.

There, CSU players and coaches will find heated, indoor driving bays that open onto Harmony's driving range, indoor and outdoor practice greens, locker facilities, a

lounge area and coach's offices.

The CSU center is another example of how Harmony's bottom line is as much about community service as it is about financial success.

The university golf teams, like homeless waifs, had worked to secure informal arrangements with public and private courses in the region for practice time and tournament hosting. Any thought of having an indoor practice facility, such as those that many competing universities in the Mountain West Conference have, was off the table until Collins stepped in with the Harmony Center idea.

The developers committed to donating 2,400 square feet of the Harmony Center building, provided a booster group called the Ram Masters could equip it.

Fort Collins investment advisor and booster club organizer Jim Smith committed his members to a \$350,000 fundraising target to provide interior finish, furnishings and equipment for the CSU golf center.

“You’ve really got to acknowledge what Byron is doing here,” Smith said at

the time the agreement was forged. “He is one of the most meticulous planners that I’ve ever been around. He’s creating this building, and making this happen for CSU.”

While CSU’s team members and coaches will become beneficiaries of Harmony’s amenities and enjoy the challenging play on Engh’s course design, others will have to purchase memberships in the private club.

Membership privileges

Developers and professional golf staff alike are sensitive to the thought that their golf club will be seen as an exclusive enclave for the rich. But compared to initiations and dues payments that other private clubs charge, Harmony is within reach of a broader base of members.

A \$12,500 payment secures a full golf membership at Harmony. That compares to private club initiation fees that typically start at \$50,000 and move steeply upward.

Lind said he had seen enough stratospheric membership fees and social exclusivity in the Las Vegas market to last him a lifetime.

“One thing I hope we never get into is that elitist status,” said Lind, who was raised on a farm in Severance. “We’re not going to be sitting there with our noses stuck in the air. We can provide world-class course and world-class service without that snobby attitude. That just doesn’t work in Northern Colorado. For the services, the clubhouse and the golf experience people are going to have there, the fee is a bargain.”

The golf experience, Harmony’s core product, is Engh’s business. Traveling in Ireland where he has another in a growing string of golf course developments under way, Engh was not available to comment on the pending opening of Harmony.

But five years ago, when Harmony was locked away in Engh’s imagination as he walked the Nelsons’ sheep farm,

he talked about the design approach that Harmony members will see when they book tee times.

“I’m a great believer in variety,” Engh said. “I love the settings for the game. Mountain golf. Prairie golf. Desert golf. The great thing about golf — the thing that makes it different from bowling, for example — is that you have these really great, beautiful places to play, all of them very different from one another.”

Engh said he also lives and works by another rule: No rules. “As long as you go at things without a rule book, you’re going to be in good shape,” he said.
