The annual Fittest Execs Challenge hosted by the *Northern Colorado Business Report* and sponsored by Banner Health saw 50 committed competitors step up. Between June 21 and Aug. 29, individuals and teams worked on their cardio fitness, their strength training, walking, playing sports and just all-round sweat-inducing activities. They also made changes to their diets to boost their performance as measured in a variety of areas.

Who was the most improved? The winners will be announced at the Fittest Execs Power Lunch at 11:30 a.m. during Bixpo. The winning team wins a free DailyEndorphin exercise challenge for their company.

Here's the list of teams represented: LPR Construction Co.; EKS&H; Great Western Bank; CTL Thompson; The Trebuchet Group; Fire Flow Protection Inc.; The FE Lone Rangers; Capital West National Bank; and Ewing Leavitt Insurance Co. Each team had at least five members, one of which was the CEO or owner of the company.

In addition to revealing who's the fittest of them all, the Fittest Execs

Power Lunch will feature a keynote address by Lorraine Bossé-Smith, president of The Total You and Concept One Inc.

She is the author of seven books, including "Fit Over 50," "Finally FIT" and "A Healthier, Happier You." Bossé-Smith is a Certified Human Behavior Consultant, life coach and personal trainer, listed in the 2000 Who's Who of Entrepreneurs and the 2005 Who's Who Among Female Executives. She holds a B.S. in Business Administration with minors in Marketing and Communications.

An active individual who plays as hard as she works, Bossé-Smith enjoys rock climbing, running, playing tennis, hiking, biking and staying fit. She lives in Loveland.

Why go through all this? It makes good business sense.

In the United States, the average sick day costs a business about \$348 in lost productivity, according to the Bureau of Labor Statistics and a study published in the *Journal of*

Occupational and Environmental Medicine. Adjusted to account for people who are sick on weekends and non-working days and because some work does get done on sick days, the cost is still approximately \$200 per sick day. But people with high levels of wellbeing get sick less often; as a result, they cost their organizations less.

Among the most "suffering" employees — those with the lowest wellbeing scores — the annual per-person cost of lost productivity due to sick days is \$28,800. For workers who are at the midpoint of the "struggling" zone, the cost is \$6,168. But for employees with the highest levels of wellbeing — those with the highest scores in the "thriving" category — the cost of lost productivity is only \$840 a year.

Given those figures, \$41 to attend the Fittest Execs Power Lunch doesn't sound like much, does it?

Ben and Jerry's Greenfield to speak at 40/40 reception

This year's class of 40/40 Leaders will be treated to a rousing tribute to the entrepreneurial spirit by one of the giants of American business.

Jerry Greenfield, who partnered with his friend, Ben Cohen, to co-found Ben and Jerry's Homemade Inc., will be the featured speaker at the 40/40 Leaders reception at Bixpo 2010 at 3 p.m.

Greenfield and Cohen built a storefront venture into a \$300 million ice cream empire by making social responsibility and creative management strengths instead of weaknesses.

Greenfield's presentation is sure to be peppered with personal anecdotes and his radical business philosophy.

Greenfield was born in Brooklyn, N.Y., and grew up on Long Island. He met his future business partner while in junior high school. They opened Ben and Jerry's Homemade Ice Cream Parlor in a hand-renovated gas station in Burlington, Vt., in 1978, with \$12,000 (\$4,000 of it borrowed). In 1980 the pair began packing their ice cream in tubs and selling it to local



grocery stores. The rest, as they say, is history, including Ben & Jerry's early and continuing support of all things environmental.

Now a division of Unilever, the company is considered a model of American business success, and although the founders are no longer part of the operation, they do have a bestselling book, "Ben and Jerry's Double Dip: Lead with Your Values and Make Money, Too."

The 40/40 reception, which will honor those Northern Colorado business leaders making a difference in the region under the age of 40, will be preceded by an invitation-only Ice Cream Social with Greenfield for 40/40 alumni, those young professionals honored in previous years.

The reception is open to the public. Tickets are \$40 and corporate tables cost \$550. Greenfield's appearance is sponsored by Community Foundation of Northern Colorado and First National Wealth Management. The 40/40 Leaders Awards are sponsored by EKS&H and A-Train Marketing.

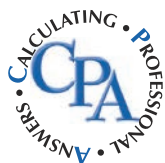

Power-packed for trade shows

Well-stocked toolbox gives powerful payoff with positive impact

Making one-on-one connections is the reason for trade shows and corporate events. You might say events are the original social media marketing: They're social; they're a form of media, and they certainly are marketing.

Like any other marketing medium a successful event has a toolbox, and here are a few of the implements you should have in yours.

First is planning. Even before your



company buys exhibitor space measure the event against your goals. Will your company get the best bang for its buck? Relatively few deals are actually closed on the floor of a trade show, but great sales relationships start there.

All of these items need to be carefully considered pre-event:

- Who is the primary target market for the event? Does it match your company's?

- How diverse is the audience? Can the message be focused, or does it need to be diversified so it makes sense to everyone?

- What is the number one point people should remember about your organization after the event?

- What do you want to achieve by participating in a trade show? Debut a product or service or generate leads, for example?

- What can you do to engage people? How can you grab their attention and give them a reason to stop so you can start a dialog? You need a "hook."

- What is your call to action? Will you have a contest/drawing? Do you want to provide attendees with a special, password-protected Web page that offers them a discount or bonus? What can you deliver that will motivate them to take action, now or after the event?

- How can you position yourself to be memorable and stand out?

Form follows message

Most companies start event planning by constructing a booth. But before you pull out the hammer, be sure the design complements the message you've developed and your plan for engagement. As you plan think about how your booth can reinforce your brand. What images

or themes can you incorporate so that people remember your booth and connect it with your organization? What display materials will you need — banners, display walls, specialized equipment? What marketing collateral will you distribute? Will you want to have prizes or promotional giveaways?

Without a doubt the most important tools in your event box are the people who will staff your booth. Even if your budget is minimal, your team can have a positive impact if each person has been thoroughly prepped pre-event. Develop scripted talking points including your

company's 30-second elevator speech and specific points that relate to whatever product or service you're highlighting. Train your team in the method of lead collection you're going to use, whether it's a mailing list sign-up sheet or a more sophisticated leads management system. Then, practice until everyone's presentation is polished and sincere.

It's important for your booth team to practice so the process will come to them naturally. Set the stage by assembling your entire booth to verify that all presentation, décor, graphics and hardware items are accounted for and working properly. Practice internally as though you are talking to a prospect. This will allow employees opportunities to recite talking points and increase comfort level in real-life situations. Test out your lead-gathering system.

Now, the day is here, and the final details are in place. You've planned, practiced and publicized your event activities — now's the time to reap the rewards and have some fun. There is only one tool left: post-event implementation.

It's time to make the investment your company made in the event fully pay off. Part of pre-planning should be a post-event action plan. Begin following up with leads immediately! Whether it's a thank-you card, e-mail or phone call, maintaining interest is paramount to furthering relationships.

And, now begin planning for the next event. Debrief and talk about what worked and what didn't. Track results — whether it's counting hits on a special URL you distributed to attendees or analyzing outcomes of your lead call-backs, it's important to measure what is and isn't effective to refine your event and prospecting strategy going forward.

You've come full circle. Your tools are polished and packed in your toolbox ready for the next successful event.

Feeling up in the air about Social Media?

It used to be that a file full of business cards was your most important asset to stay in touch with business professionals and prospects. Now they're just good for door-stops.

Social Media is the modern version of a Rolodex for all the right reasons. Here are just a few:

- Be Top of Mind with your prospects –daily if you like!
- Listen Up! Hear what your competition is saying and doing – stealth marketing at its finest.
- Establish yourself as an expert on your topic(s).
- Increase brand recognition and share more value regularly.
- Reach thousands of people you otherwise wouldn't.
- Have personal connections with prospects and clients without artificial barriers.
- Connect with people globally, regionally, in the state, next door.
- Leverage that six degrees of separation you always hear about!
- Announce your new products and have others fan the fire of your fame for you.
- Be visibly generous to your clients and customers.
- Partner with businesses and invent new ways of going to market with them.
- Be seen and build your business by becoming that much more prominent.
- Appeal to the next generations of



customers coming around the corner.

- Reduce expenditures for customer service and even marketing – as you answer questions exponentially and promote more widely.
- Get found on Google and Bing – they're watching what your company is saying in social spheres with real time search.
- Respond to any criticisms about your company visibly and assuredly – reputation management.
- Gauge what the marketplace wants – and deliver it.

Sure we've heard people say, I don't care what someone is having for breakfast. And I certainly don't use "the

Twitter." But social media is not a fad. It's here for the long term. Why? Because it's just efficient marketing.

This is what we call "PDR" – personal digital relations. It's you and your company in the limelight, without any intermediaries. Nobody getting in the way of you telling your story and being personal and prominent.

Next Steps?

Once you're convinced you need to be doing Social Media, you'll want to think about who you are going to have do the work. Will this become an internal problem, back at the office? Who's going to be the face of the company?

Maybe you'll outsource it. But who

can you trust to understand and represent your business maturely and with uncommon intelligence?

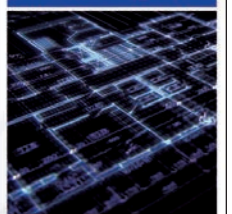

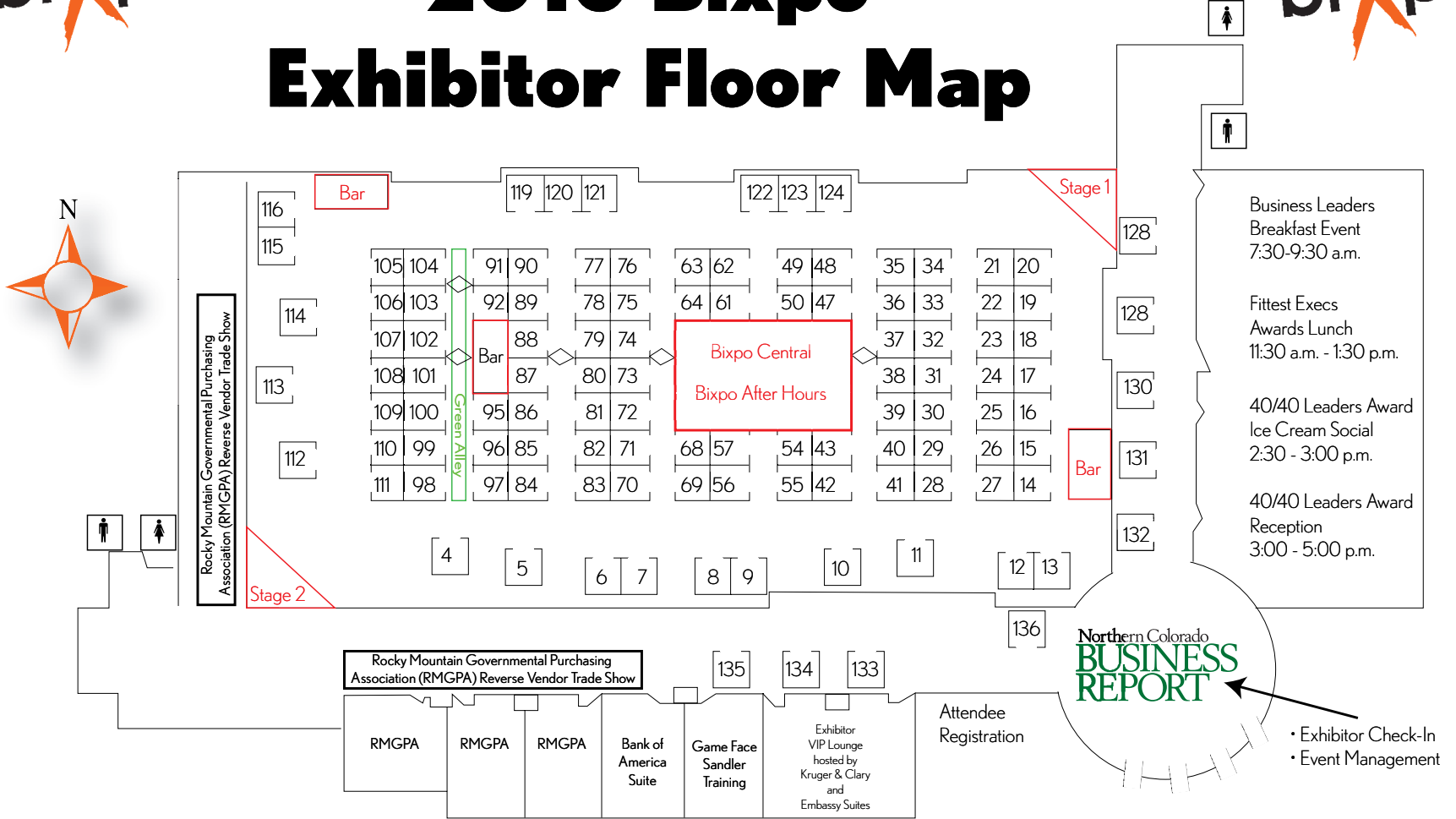

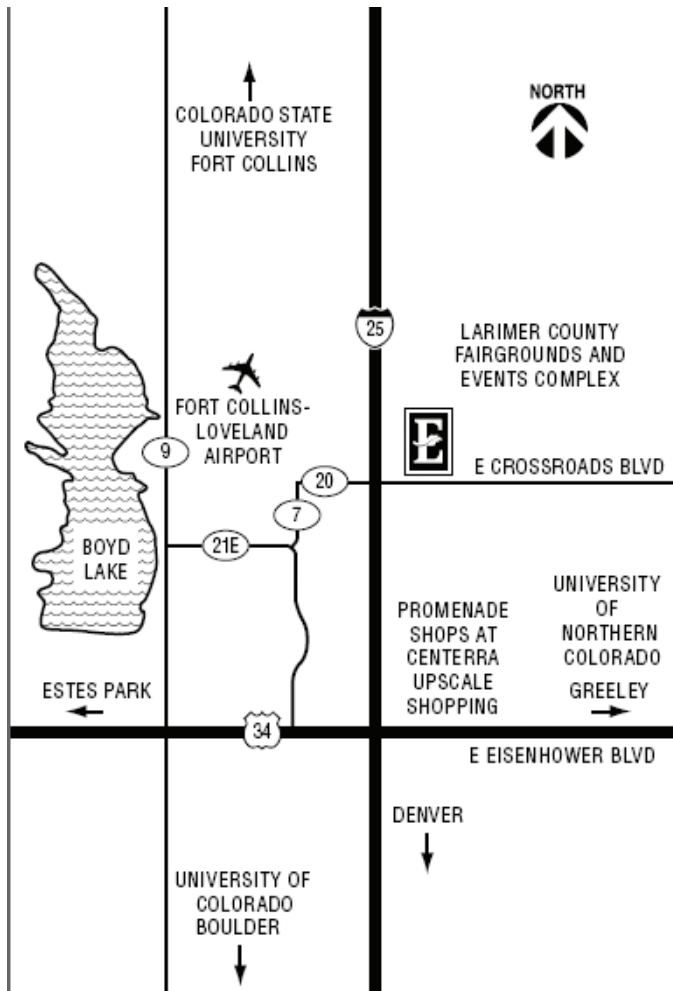
