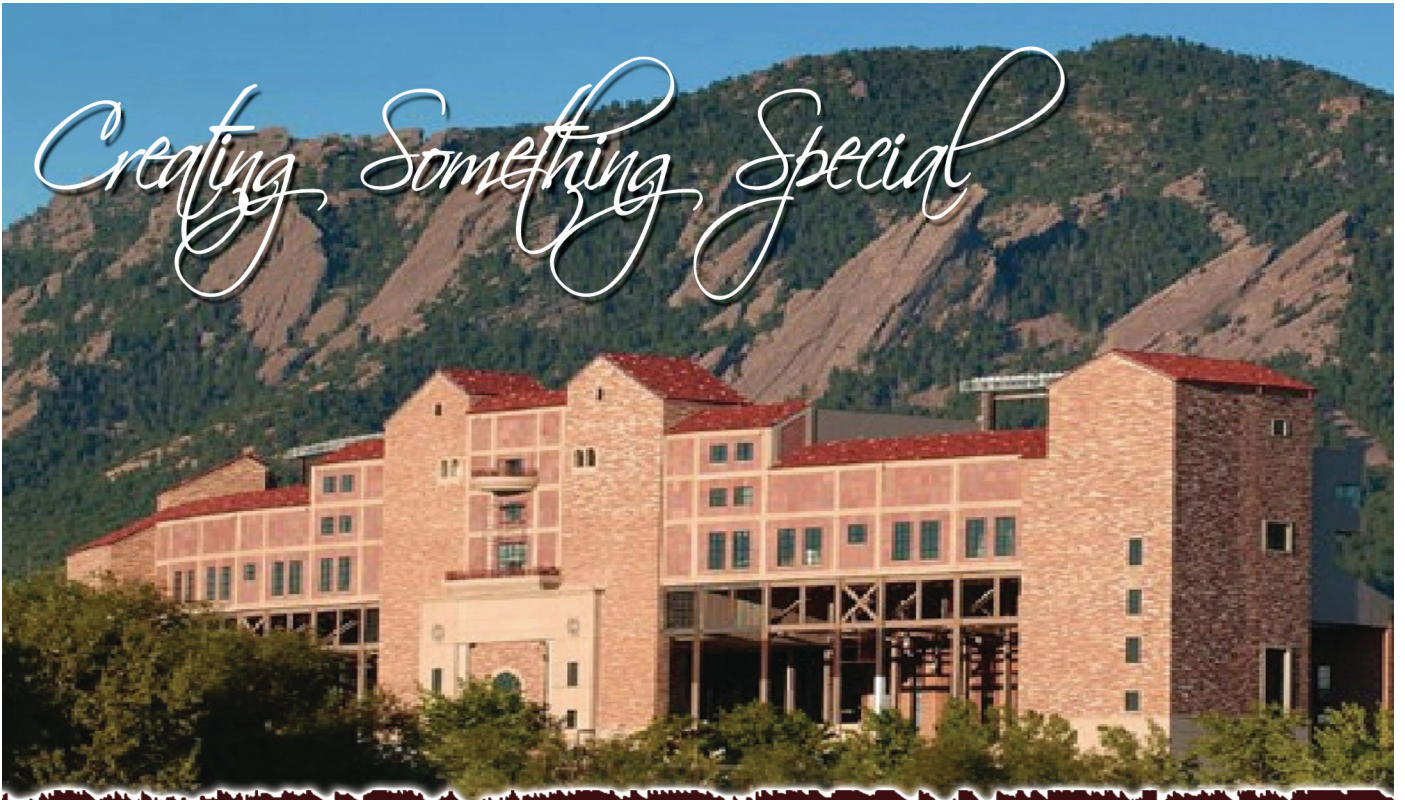

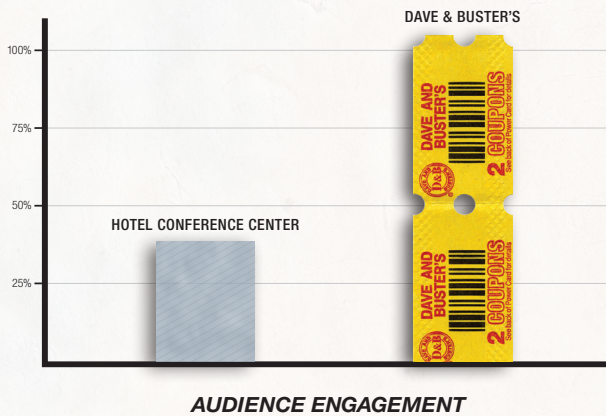

# The Ideal Venue

Your goals will dictate best place for your event

Choosing a venue for your event is the most critical part of your planning. Several things need to be considered. If you choose an area that is too large, it will look as if your event is not well attended. You also don't want to choose a venue that is too small.

"When you're planning an event, you need someone who knows what they are doing from the very beginning," said Tracy Breithaupt, owner of the event planning company Abinitio Designs in Boulder. That was the inspiration behind her company name. The word "abinitio"

means "from the beginning" in Latin.

The first thing people think about from the beginning is cost.

"Say the base price is \$20,000," Breithaupt said. "Sometimes, based on food and beverage revenue, you can have the site for free. That comes into play in the negotiations. They may offer the site to you for \$15,000, but that might not include costs above that base fee. You really have to look at that. Lighting staging, catering, entertainment — all that is put into play in considering whether a venue will work."

Judy Bigger with The Atwood Company in Boulder also considers the staff when choosing a venue.

"The staff can make or break an event," Bigger said. "The staff at some venues is

# Getting It Right



Events

Any time an event goes really well, it's something to be proud of.

Making an event a success and one that people will remember requires some attention to detail. If you've planned a similar event before, repeat what worked, and eliminate what didn't. Otherwise, consider these tips.

Determine the goals and objectives of the event up front, and make sure they are clear before you start getting the word out. It's also a good idea to have a theme for the event.

Assess your needs. Write down what you are looking for in facility, food, transportation, audio-visual services and other needs. Also consider the age, gender and background of the attendees and who they will bring with them.

Create a list of things that need to be done and who is in charge of doing them. Check off each thing as it gets done.

Promotion is critical. You've got to make sure people know about the event and when it is. Make phone calls. Send out letters and invitations, pass out flyers, or hang posters. Do whatever it takes to provide as much publicity as possible where it will be seen by the people who you want to attend.

The event's promotion should also appeal to the intended audience.

"Make sure the method you use for the promotion matches the audience you're trying to reach," said Rosalie Sheffield, events manager for the Boulder Chamber of Commerce. "If you're looking a tech-savvy audience, you might want to send an e-mail and have an online-based

amazing. They go out of their way to accommodate you. They can either make the event very enjoyable or make you want to pull your hair out."

These tips are only a few things to consider in choosing the appropriate venue. Here is a check list on how to tackle event planning like a pro:

### Identify and stick to the objective

- Before you make your first phone call or order nametags, answer these key questions:
  - What is the purpose of the meeting? (reward performance, improve morale, educate, etc.)
  - Does this meeting have a documented history? (If so, learn from it. If not, start one now.)
  - What is the budget?
  - Who will attend? (employees or employees and their families, etc.)
  - Where will it be? (local or out of town)

### Prepare request for proposal

Developing a request for proposal, or RFP, may take extra time, but it will save you headaches, hassles and sleepless nights in the long run. Also, research possible venues online, in the phone book or in local publications. Many event-planning Web sites offer sample RFPs; some will even send them for you.

### Assess your top choice

Once you have narrowed down your responses, you will want to tour a facility (or two) and meet the venue's representative before making the final decision. Consider making this appointment at the same time of day on the same day of the week as the event. Take along pen, paper and measuring tape, and address the following (this assumes your event is indoors, but remember that outdoor venues are a creative alternative):

### Venue

- Image and appearance. Does it match your function goal?
- Parking. Is it ample? Is there a fee?
- Signage. Will the facility supply signage from entrance to function room?
- Cleanliness. Insider tip: check bathrooms to discern facility's attention to detail.
- Will a representative be available throughout the event, just in case?
- Is a construction project scheduled near the time of your event?
- Is a large group scheduled at the same time as your function? How will you be affected?
- Sleeping accommodations. If any guests will be staying overnight, ask to see a room.

### Meeting room

- How are the acoustics? You want to hear your speaker but not the one next door.
- What floor plans have been successful for groups similar in size?
- What are the audio-visual equipment capabilities?

### Catering policy

- What is the catering policy?

### Cost

- Request an itemized list of all costs.
- Is there anything the list does not include that you must provide, such as security personnel?
- What hours of rental are included, and how are extra hours billed?

### Get it in writing

Professional event planners insist on contracts. The venue representative may encourage you to sign it on the spot, but pros recommend you review it carefully before signing. Here are some particulars your contract should contain:

- A date guarantee.
- Access times.
- The cost itemization mentioned above.
- All specifications outlined in RFP or discussed with representative.
- Refund policy.

Experts recommend that you keep meticulous notes throughout the planning process. The next time you choose a facility, an event history will be an indispensable resource.

registration.”

Communicate with attendees beforehand so they come prepared. Use the Internet as a resource. You can use online registration, online site selection and Web research tools. Also, you can e-mail people information about the event.

Sheffield said the initial invitations should be sent out at least six months before the event so people can put it on their calendars.

Always plan well in advance. Ideally, a conference should be planned at least a year ahead of time. Conference centers and resorts book large events from one year to three years beforehand.

“It should be no less than about 18 months out. The reason for that is because the first thing to do is get the venue,” said Jean Atwood, owner of Boulder-based The Atwood Company, an event planning consultancy. “So many venues are contracted that far in advance, and your options will be limited if you don’t start planning and contract your venue that far out.”

If you’re organizing an in-house party or summer picnic, Atwood said to plan six months in advance.

Try using professional event planners because they can save you time and money. They know the right questions to ask and the tricks of the trade. They can also help with site inspection and selection.

As a general rule of thumb, if you’re organizing an internal event such as an employee holiday party, expect 50 percent to 75 percent of the people you invite to show up.

Provide specific activities that attendees can participate in. Being actively involved at least part of the time is better than just sitting and listening.

Make sure the speakers and entertainment are visible to all attendees. Attendees should also not have any trouble hearing. Check well ahead of time to ensure that the microphones and other audio-visual equipment work.

“I think audio/visual is extremely important. There is a lot of preplanning involved, and you should set a time – earlier in the day of the event – to do a run through, so people know when to go

up and down off stage and make sure the sound is good,” Sheffield said.

Comfort is also crucial. No one wants to sit for hours in an uncomfortable chair or be in an overcrowded room. Any time

people experience discomfort, they focus on that as opposed to the event.

The facility needs to be the right size, not too big and not too small.

“Each event has its own personality, and the venue depends on the audience and the presentation,” Sheffield said. “I look at a lot

# Making last-minute event come off without a hitch

Whether you have a few weeks or a few days to plan an event, last-minute event planning isn't impossible. You can handle it.

"I would say anything under two weeks is definitely short notice," said Debbie Mallick, owner of Broomfield-based The Party's On LLC.

While stress can be high when planning on the fly, there are a handful of tips local professionals give when planning a last-minute event.

"You've got to be organized, and you have to start with a checklist," said Lance Jaeger, owner of Superior-based Foothills Event Management LLC.

### Know the basics

Why are you having the event? What style of event will it be? Who is your intended audience? If you can answer those three questions, you're on the right track. Consider this:

**Demographics:** Are you targeting family and friends, co-workers, business contacts, the media or the general public? And remember to be realistic on how many people will attend – not how many you are inviting.

**Nature of the event:** Are you trying to network, launch a product, announce a

# Sweat the Details

## Take time to study contract's fine print

When planning for an event – whether it be a corporate party or wedding – contracts between you and your event planners and caterers likely will need to be signed.

In the rush to organize the event, don't forget to go over these contracts with the service providers and read the fine print.

Here are some things to watch for in an

event contract, as explained by some area caterers and event planners.

### The small details matter

"Everyone has a different idea on how things should be done at an event," said Linda Aquimo, owner of Broomfield-based Garden Grill Catering. "The time the food should be served, how it should be served. ... If they've got one thing in mind, and I've

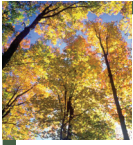
got another thing in mind, then we're in trouble."

Aquimo said she leaves room on her contracts for the customer to add customized expectations, so that both parties know what is expected.

### Are the prices guaranteed?

In the past year, food, flower and other

material prices have jumped due to higher fuel costs. Make sure if you're planning way ahead for the event, that the prices today will be the same at the time of the event, said David Rubin, president and co-owner of Boulder-based A Spice of Life Centers & Catering Services.

"We don't pass on those price increases in mid-contract," Rubin said. "But for our annual events my clients can expect about 3 percent rise in costs for each subsequent year of the event. This year has really hit us hard with increasing costs."

### Changes in food, attendance

Be aware of deadlines when you can last make changes to the contact, such as how many guests will be attending or changes in food. For example, be sure to let the caterer know how many vegetarian plates are needed.

At Boulder-based Redstone Catering, owner Dan Dietrich has a 10-day before-the-event deadline.

"Should the number of guests go up, we make every effort to accommodate their needs, but we can't guarantee the availability of all services to everyone," he said.

### Deposits and fees

Be aware of deadlines when you can last cancel the event and

avoid losing a lot of money. Most catering and event companies will require a nonrefundable deposit. Others will also require a nonrefundable down payment if the event is canceled closer to the day of the event.

### Location matters

Depending on whether you chose an onsite location at a restaurant or catering company to service the event off site, there will be a significant price difference. Onsite restaurant events tend to be set in cost based on the number of people being served. For off-site events, the prices can vary, Rubin said.

For example, with higher fuel costs, the prices to transport people and materials to an off-site venue have increased, he said.

### Meet in person

In today's fast-paced world, a lot of communication is done via phone or e-mail. This is one time when you should meet in person with your event planner or caterer, especially if this is the first time you are using them.

"It's important to meet with them face-to-face" Aquino said. "Because sometimes personalities clash."

Communicate early on with caterers to make sure you get the food you want. If you give them time, they can customize your menu, enhancing the experience for your guests.

a merger, celebrate a grand opening or educate the community?

Jeans or black tie: Are you hoping to have a backyard BBQ with guests clad in jeans and T-shirts or are you thinking of an chic masquerade with tuxedos and evening gowns?

"That ties into the budget," Jaeger said. "It ties into what you need to pull off the event a lot of times."

#### **Get the logistics**

After deciding upon the basics of event planning, the first action step is to figure out when you want your event and where. Consider this:

Date and time: Do you want to host an event midweek, on the weekend, in the morning, or perhaps all day? Is it crunch time and you want the event in three days or are you planning it a few weeks out?

Venue: Do you need a permit and tent for

a party in the park, a partitioned ballroom with elegant tables for a retirement party or something in between?

"They need to be flexible," Mallick said. "Especially for finding the venue at the last minute. It should be the first call you make not the last call."

#### **Show me the money**

While planning a last-minute event can save money under some circumstances (an empty venue or unreserved caterer may want the business), charges and rush fees are often passed to the customer. Consider this:

- Food and drink: While good caterers can often get food quickly if they have at least two days notice, anything less than that is typically considered a rush order which will cost more. Depending on the size of the event, consider a restaurant that caters or choose to dine in.

Budget: Know what you have to work with in terms of finances, and be flexible if you have to adjust your budget accordingly.

- A lot of people have the champagne wishes and the beer budget," Mallick said.

#### **Spread the word**

Your contacts list and your time until the event will often determine how you spread the word about your function. Consider this:

More than a week: If you have a few weeks and a good mailing list, send invites via snail mail because it's more formal albeit more expensive.

Less than a week: If you're a few days out, send emails or e-vites and follow it with a phone call. It's less formal, but it's fast and cheap.

"It's always good to send something (via mail), but you can always back it up with other methods as well," Jaeger said.

#### **Emphasize what counts**

Think of the events you've attended recently. What stuck out as really good or really bad? Typically, Jaeger said, it comes down to a handful of topics that can make or break an event. Consider this:

Was there enough to eat and drink and was it good?

Were the bathrooms easily accessible, clean and functional?

What did guests get for free (for instance a CD, T-shirt or pen set)?

"Memorable doesn't always have to be expensive," Jaeger said. "Use your creativity."

#### **Flexibility**

The key to planning an event on the fly is to be flexible. Don't have your mind set on the best venue or caterer that's always booked because they're probably booked. One thing some event planners like about last minute events is that people are forced to make a decision and stick with it. So do that. Time is against you, but make the most of it.

"You've got to stay calm under pressure," Jaeger said.

When in doubt, call an event planner either for a consultation or to have him do the work.

### PCD makes energy efficiency easier

*Engineering firm analyzes building, provides assistance*

LONGMONT – PCD Engineering Services Inc. is working to make residential and commercial buildings energy efficient and has seen its business grow despite the recent real estate slowdown.

According to Peter D'Antonio, owner of the Longmont-based engineering firm, the company has grown 50 percent every year of its eight years in business.

When the company started, D'Antonio was its only employee. The company now has four full-time employees and an electrical consultant it refers to for projects.

"We're focused on building efficiency, and that is not slowing down," D'Antonio said. PCD offers building systems analysis and design services.

The company starts with the building envelope. It look at the glass, walls and roof as well as the systems inside that consume energy such as heating, cooling and lighting.

Part of the business – about 25 percent – is retrofitting a building to be more efficient.

"It's much harder retrofitting a building for efficiency," D'Antonio said, but he added that he can still improve the building's efficiency by 10 percent to 30 percent.

The company can improve efficiency by 30 percent to more than 50 percent in a new building.

"We just did a building in southern Colorado that produces all its energy on site. We've done a lot of net-zero buildings," D'Antonio said.

In net-zero the renewable energy systems generate all the energy the business uses.

D'Antonio said some utility companies – including Xcel Energy – will actually "let you spin your meter backward" and at the end of the year will "reconcile and send you a check."

The issue with this is that the utility company will pay you back at wholesale prices, which is less than what it charges. PCD, which is an Energy Star service provider, also works for utility companies and helps their customers by conducting energy audits and design assistance.

"We help their customers identify and implement energy projects in (their) building. We help them understand how to be more efficient and garner energy rebates," D'Antonio said.

The company also does commissioning, which is basically like a tune up. PCD uncovers a lot of operational problems with commissioning.

"It's really quick things you don't have to spend a lot of money on," D'Antonio said.

PCD has done a lot for Boulder-based Bryan Bowen Architects.

"They are pretty innovative and are willing to analyze things that are weird," said Bryan Bowen, the firm's owner. He said typical mechanical engineers

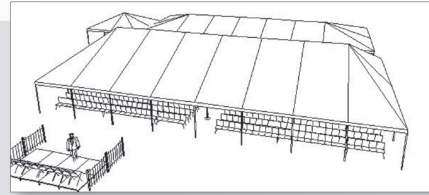
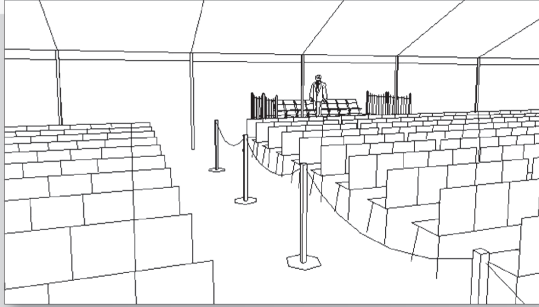
