Pine also wrote the award-winning "Mass Customization: The New Frontier in Business Competition" (Harvard Business School Press, 1993), and edited, with Gilmore, a collection of Harvard Business Review articles, "Markets of One: Creating Customer-Unique Value through Mass Customization" (Harvard Business School Press, 2000). Pine has also written numerous articles for the Harvard Business Review, The Wall Street Journal, Chief Executive, Worldlink, CIO,

Set your corporate goal: Successful Bixpo exhibit

LOVELAND — "If you build it, they will come" might work in the movies, but as a methodology for maximizing your effort at trade shows — and marketing in general — it usually misses the mark. Merely throwing your booth together and handing out business cards might not generate the results you're looking for — especially if you're not entirely clear what those results should be.

As with any venture a company may take, there must be a goal. Companies come to Bixpo with a variety of goals, but everyone wants to see a return on investment.

The problem with trade-show ROIs is they can be difficult to calculate precisely. Did you get your new customer because of your exhibit? Or have they seen your marketing materials or talked to a salesperson in the past? Or is it a combination of all of your marketing efforts? Instead of focusing on trade-show ROIs, focus on an objective and measure the success in reaching that objective.

Companies use trade shows for a variety of reasons including, gathering sales leads, reinforcing existing relationships, launching new products or marketing messages, raising visibility, recruiting new hires or landing that big customer. Exhibitors with fewer and more focused objectives are likely to be more successful. Fewer variables will make it easier to garner measurable results.

Strategize to reach objective

Once you've developed an objective, come up with a strategy to reach that objective.

- Almost 75 percent of trade-show attendees plan their booth visits before the show starts. Become part of attendees' plans by promoting your booth prior to the event and using multiple messages through multiple media. That means sending out emails or direct-mail pieces to potential leads containing a message that's cohesive with your objective. Send out press releases, newsletters and advertisements. As the show nears, make e-mail or phone calls to potential leads to set up appointments, and consider placing an ad in the event's program.
- After you've developed your preshow marketing plan, it's time consider how you'll set up your booth. You don't have much time to make sure a show attendee understands your message. Avoid confusing them by creating a clean, clear and simple booth. Ensure your visitor receives the information they need to make a decision favorable to your company. That's all they need and that's all you want.
- Trade-show attendees pass hundreds of booths. Make your booth stand out among them by using eye-grabbers and lots of light. Eye-grabbers could be anything from desirable giveaways or drawings to a meaningful message spelled out with graphics or text. Using lots of light will help attract attendees to your booth people pay extra attention to what's in the spot-

■ Make your booth approachable. A

booth with a company video playing and no booth staffer present won't get much traffic. Make sure someone is manning your booth at all times and create an atmosphere that invites attendees to stop and talk to you. This could be as simple as having a friendly person greeting attendees as they pass. It's easy to pass by a booth with silent booth staffers sitting meekly behind their company products. Stand up and smile — this is an opportunity to sell

Don't forget the followup

If you have successfully attracted attendees to your booth, get their contact information. You've generated a lead, now follow up with them. If your product interests someone, persistence pays off. Business people are busy — they need and want reminders.

Track the outcome of each of the leads you develop at the event. If you land even one faithful customer, think about what that could mean for your company throughout the relationship.

After the show, determine whether you've met your objectives. Were you able to hire that new employee? Did you generate 50 solid leads? Did you get a chance to network with some of your existing clients?

Determine which factors helped or inhibited your ability to meet that objective. Make adjustments to your strategy based on your findings and you can look forward to increasing success as an exhibitor.
